Please find below the itinerary and kit list for the above trip:

Itinerary

Monday 18th: Meet on the quay at 1:45pm (please note that the Scillonian sailing time is 14:30). Your child should either bring a packed tea for the journey or money to buy a meal on board. St Martin's children will boat over to St Mary's in the morning and spend the morning with Yachts Class or meet us on the quay at 1.45pm.

We will be met in Penzance and taken by minibus to Ludgvan School, who have kindly offered to accommodate us in their hall. After setting up our sleeping area we will have evening games and a story before bed.

Tuesday 19th: After breakfast, courtesy of Ludgvan breakfast club, we will go by minibus to St Buryan School, together with 8 Y5 children from Ludgvan School. Here we will be joined by Y5 friends from St Hilary and St Buryan for our morning workshop and school lunch (your child will be asked for their lunch choice in advance). This will be followed by a creative afternoon workshop and a closing sharing of our project outcomes.

We will return to Ludgvan school for some relaxing time, and then enjoy an early evening meal out in Penzance together, thanks to the help of Ludgvan staff and their minibus! Then it will be time once again to set up our sleeping area in the school hall, have quiet games and a story before bed.
