Itinerary

Tuesday 26th: Meet on the quay at 3:45pm. Board Scillonian III at 4pm. Your child should either bring a packed tea for the journey or money to buy a meal on board. We will be met in Penzance and be taken by minibus to Ludgvan School, who have kindly offered to accommodate us again. After setting up our sleeping area we will have quiet games and a story before bed.

Wednesday 27th: After breakfast, courtesy of Ludgvan breakfast club, we will go by minibus to Penzance. We will start with a visit to Sainsbury's where children may choose sandwiches, and other food for their 'packed tea' and get a little bit of retail therapy! We will then walk into Penzance, where, if there is time, we will visit The Exchange to enjoy some contemporary art. We will be going to The Savoy Cinema for our main meal before watching Migration. We will then go to St John's Hall to meet fellow choirs for a full rehearsal. We will then have time to relax and eat our packed tea. After the concert finishes at 8:45pm, we will travel back to Ludgvan by taxi and go straight to bed.

Thursday 29th: We will pack everything away, and after breakfast we will travel back to Penzance quay by minibus and board the Scillonian for our return crossing which departs at 9:15. We will arrive back at St Mary's quay at 12:00.
