Our trip to the Cornwall Music Festival is now nearly upon us so please see below some final details and kit list.

Please bring your child up to the airport (in home clothes) at 9:15 on the morning of Wednesday 13th March, ready to catch the 10:10 flight. There is no need to come to school first. We will then be travelling by Mount's Bay mini-bus to Truro, where we will drop our bags at the **Hotel Vara** (where we are staying) before finding a nice spot to eat our packed lunches. The afternoon will then hopefully involve:

1. Visiting the Hall For Cornwall where Jeremy Brown has arranged for the children to sing one or two of their songs in front of some staff at Hall For Cornwall!
2. Taking part in a 45 minute workshop about what a career in the arts can look like.
3. Rehearsing at the Methodist Church with the festival pianist
4. A quick stop off for the 'essential' mainland shopping on the High Street!

In the evening, we will have tea at Pizza Express!

On Thursday morning, after breakfast in the hotel, we will walk to the Truro Methodist Church ready to perform at 9:40am. If you have friends or family on the mainland that would like to support us, please tell them to **arrive by 9:30am** at the latest.

Once we have finished at the festival, we will have some lunch in Truro before being picked up in the mini-bus by a colleague from Mount's Bay, ready to make our return journey. We will return on the 15:55 and children will need to be collected from the airport at 16:15.
